

# TEAM VALOR INTERNATIONAL REACHES DOUBLE DIGITS IN STAKES WINS KENTUCKY-BASED STABLE WIDENS LEAD IN '11 PARTNERSHIP STANDINGS ON TOP OF DERBY TRIUMPH, OUTFIT IS WINNING AT EXCELLENT 21% CLIP



Team Valor racked up its 10<sup>th</sup> stakes win of 2011 last week in South Africa. The crimson and green crew has more than twice as many stakes wins as any other stable of syndicated horses.

Team Valor will seek its sixth graded stakes triumph of the year on August 13 with Crimson China (left) in the Grade 1 Secretariat Stakes at Arlington Park. By comparison, last year at this point, Team Valor had eight stakes wins and two graded stakes wins.

With four months remaining, Team Valor has reached the \$3-million mark in stable earnings for 2011 and is well within reach of its best year's total, \$3,888,233 in 2007 when the stable had roughly

33% more runners.

Keys to this year's haul include Animal Kingdom's Kentucky Derby victory—he remains the highest-earning horse in the U.S. this year—and a strong 21.1% win percentage that, if the season ended today, would be the stable's highest since 2003.
