**TEAM VALOR LEADS ALL PUBLIC PARTNERSHIPS IN STAKES WINNERS, IT HAS NEARLY TRIPLE THE NUMBER OF STAKES WINS AS RUNNER-UP, KENTUCKY STABLE HAS WON 17 STAKES, 10 GRADED IN THIS SEASON, BARRY IRWIN'S STABLE HAS WON MAJOR RACES 3 OF LAST 4 WEEKS**

Team Valor International, with important international victories on 3 of the last 4 weekends, leads of North American partnership stables in all major categories involving number of stakes winners. The chart below shows the Kentucky-based stable leading its competitors in number of stakes victories (17 to 6), number of stakes winners (12 to 5), number of Graded stakes winners (6 to 4) and number of Graded stakes scores (10 to 4).

Saturday Team Valor International saw its 3-year-old filly Ebony Flyer remain unbeaten in 4 starts when she was a daylight winner of South Africa's most prestigious race for sophomore fillies, the Grade 1 Cape Fillies Guineas, which is the lone Grade 1 Guineas carded for fillies and is the first Classic race of the season.

Last weekend Team Valor won the Grade 1 Matriarch at Hollywood with Gypsy's Warning and 2 weeks earlier home-bred Pluck won the \$1-million Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. The former was bought in South Africa and Pluck was produced by a mare bred and raced in South Africa.

Team Valor has won 55 races with a 20.30 winning strike rate and earnings of \$3,123,058 in 2010.
