Barry Irwin is a former fiction writer who, in 1969, became a staff writer for The Blood-Horse. He returned to his home state to write for and later edit the Thoroughbred of California magazine. He also wrote a Southern California column in Daily Racing Form (DRF) and hosted radio and television programs on racing.

During that period, he became an owner and won with his first two starters. Irwin left DRF at the close of the 1978 Del Mar meet to become a bloodstock agent on a full-time basis. In 1987, Irwin co-founded Clover Racing Stable, which later became Team Valor. Through those racehorse syndicate organizations, Irwin bred, raced, syndicated, bought and sold several hundred horses, including It's the One, African Sky, Moscow Ballet and Torsion.

In 2007, Irwin bought out longtime partner Jeff Siegel and renamed his stable Team Valor International, which campaigned 2011 Kentucky Derby winner Animal Kingdom. Team Valor International partnerships annually donate one percent of their worldwide racetrack earnings—and Team Valor International, itself, matches that figure—to The Race For Education, a charity offering college scholarships to the children of backstretch and farm workers.
